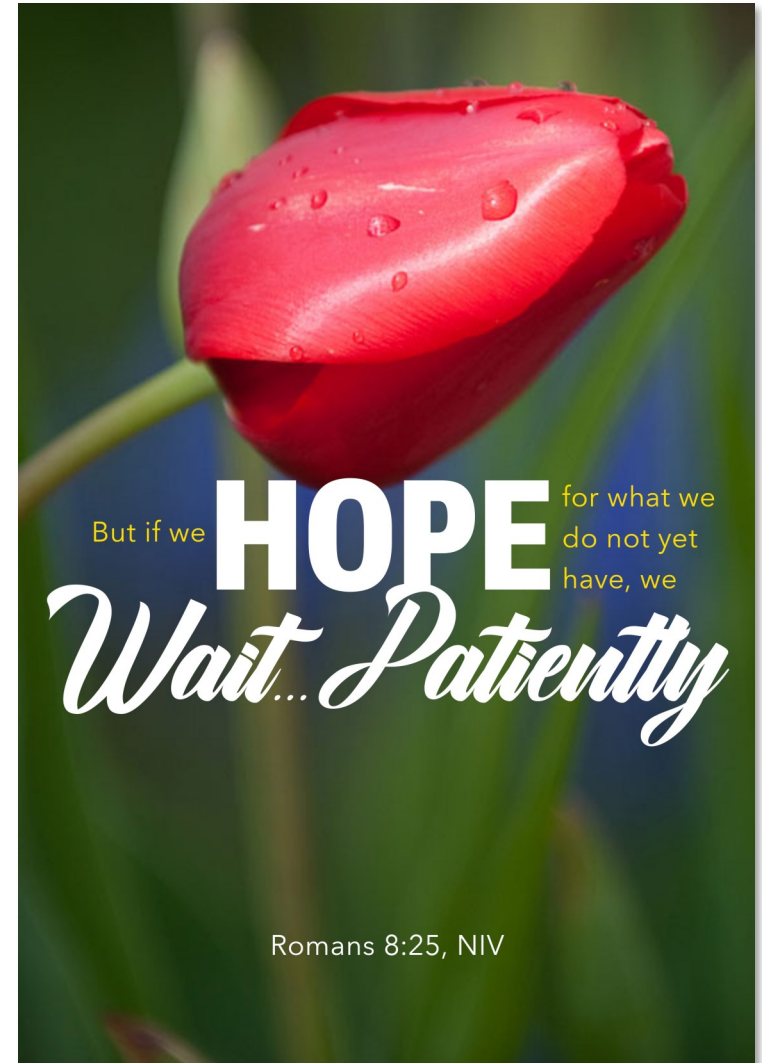

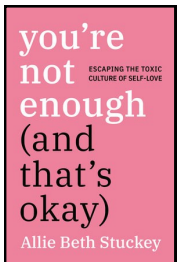
Join us for breakfast and a time of fellowship on March 21st from 8—8:45 a.m. in the fellowship hall.
