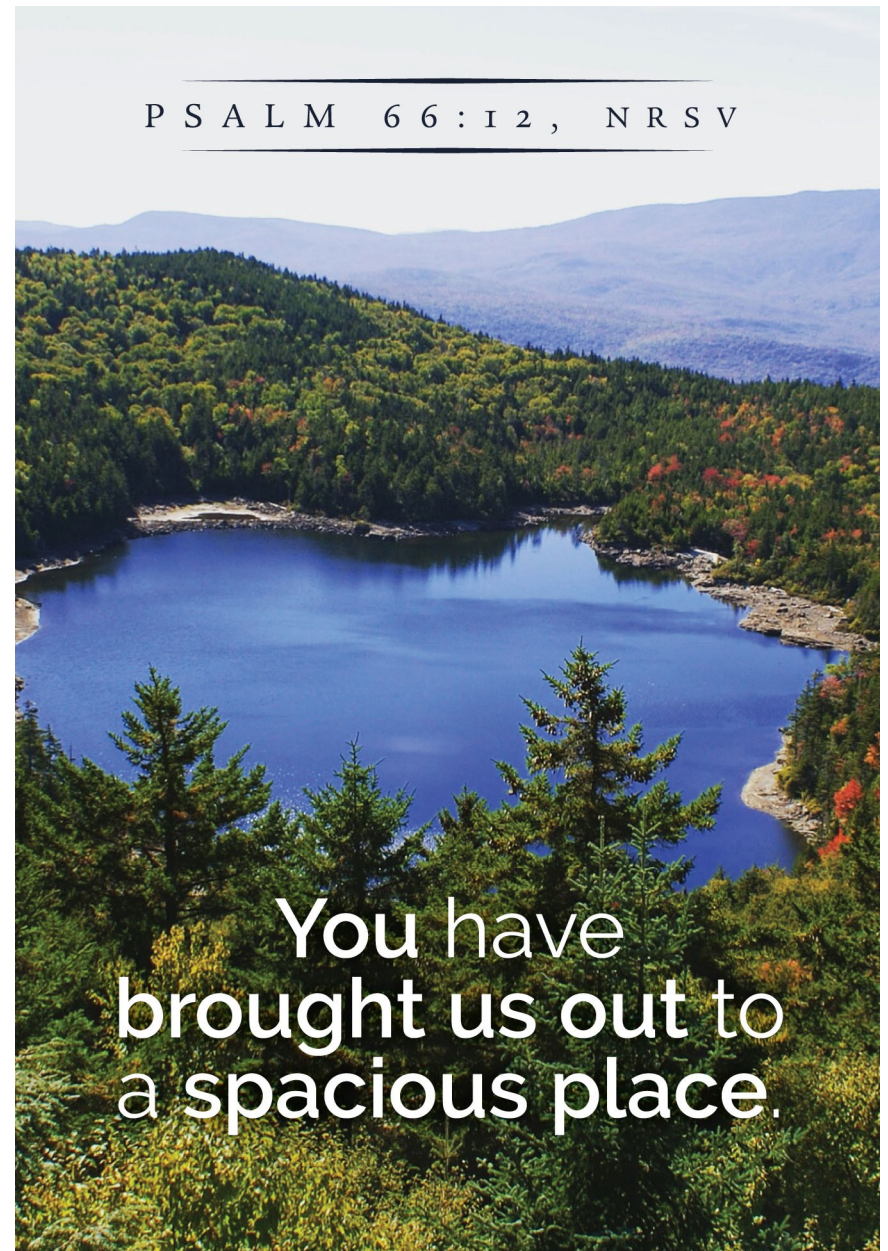

**Something to think about...**

In Paul's first letter to Timothy, he writes of his spiritual journey from what he once was, how he was saved, and now what he has become (1 Tim 1:12-16). The grace of God turned Paul from a persecutor into a preacher - the murderer into a missionary! The change God made in his life was so dramatic that the church in Jerusalem thought it might be a trick. God gave Paul his ministry. And while none of us has had the same experience that Paul had on the Damascus road, he is proof that the grace of God can change *any* sinner - even us!

If we have been changed by the grace of God, we have a story to tell to those that live in the darkness of the world. We, too have ALL been commissioned by God to take the light - the message of the Gospel - to those He brings into our lives.
